WHAT TO BRING

For your convenience, a suggested clothing and equipment list is provided here in your staff materials. Ample “cubby” space is provided in each cabin for storage.

The temperature at camp is quite nice, allowing for shorts and T-shirts during the day (85-95 degrees). Slightly warmer clothing is recommended during the evenings (65-75 degrees). Laundry service will be available to staff for a small fee (complimentary for out-of-state staff) throughout the summer.
