

Upload Form I-9 Identification Document(s)

Upload a copy (or copies) of your identification through your [CBM CampInTouch Account](#) in the *Forms Dashboard* under *Forms and Documents*.

Only certain IDs are acceptable, and the full list is below. You have 2 options for uploading your ID(s):

OPTION 1: Upload 1 ID

Upload a document from "LIST A" to **Form I-9: Identification #1**.

Tip: Use your Passport here.

OPTION 2: Upload 2 IDs

Upload a document from "LIST B" to **Form I-9: Identification #1**.

Tip: Use your Driver's License or State Photo ID here.

AND

Upload a document from "LIST C" to **Form I-9: Identification #2 (If uploading 2 IDs)**.

Tip: Use your Social Security Card or Birth Certificate here.
