








Health / Medication Information






TRUE Pharmacy






Atlanta Bus

- June 4th, June 29, July 3rd and July 28th
- Ameris Bank Amphitheatre All Atlanta campers *must* use this option. Others welcome to use it also.
- Drop off times are between 12:30pm and 2:30pm.
- Pick up times are between 12:30pm and 3pm with specific times and other details supplied via email when we get closer.
- Upon arrival staff will guide you through the drop off and pickup process.
